

ORDINANCE NO. 565

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SPEED LIMIT ON STATE HIGHWAY NO. 68, BETWEEN THE EAST AND WEST CITY LIMITS OF GOLDEN. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 554 of the Ordinances of the City of Golden is hereby repealed and reenacted with amendments to read:

Section 7. Only emergency parking will be permitted on through way. Upon the basis of engineering and traffic investigations by the Department of Highways, State of Colorado, and by said City, it has been determined that a reasonable and true prima facie speed limit on said portion of said through highway shall be FIFTY (50) miles per hour, provided that standard signs are erected giving notice of authorized speed as provided by Chapter 13, Article 5. Sections 33 (4) and 34 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1963.

Section 2. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 554 shall be uneffected by this Ordinance and shall remain in full force and effect as previously passed.
