

ORDINANCE NO. 325

AN ORDINANCE TERMED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1952.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

That the fiscal year ending the 31st day of December, A. D. 1952, the following sums of money, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to defray the expenses and liabilities of the City of Golden, to-wit:

First: \$75,263.23, to pay the water and sewer expenses of the said City. The total sum to be spent in the following manner:

A. \$23,937.50, Water Maintenance.
B. \$1,800.00, Water Depreciation Fund.

C. \$15,000.00, For payment of outstanding Water Bonds of said City.

D. \$7,197.50, To pay the interest on the outstanding Water Bonds of said City.

E. \$5,000.00, Sewer Maintenance.
F. \$22,328.23, Is hereby appropriated for use during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1952, from the sewer and water fund created by Ordinances Numbered 191, 192, 225, 227, 253, and 270, for construction.

Second: \$79,424.98, To pay the General and Incidental expenses of said City, not otherwise provided for.

B. \$4,750.00, City Manager.
C. \$1,244.00, City Attorney.
D. \$3,000.00, City Engineer.
E. \$500.00, City Hall.
F. \$1,229.00, City or Police Magistrate.
G. \$498.00, Audit.
H. \$4,900.00, Finance.
I. \$ -----, Elections.
J. \$25.00, Planning.
K. \$20,500.00, Police Department Maintenance.
L. \$3,117.00, Fire Department Maintenance.
M. \$5,400.00, Golden Cemetery.
N. \$900.00, Library Maintenance.
O. \$22,496.98, To construct and keep in repair the Streets, Alleys and Bridges, of the said City, together with culverts sidewalks, and cross-walks.
P. \$1,755.00, Sanitation, City Dump Maintenance, and Garbage Disposal.
Q. \$3,000.00, Street Lighting.
R. \$1,000.00, National Civil Defense.
S. \$4,000.00, Parks and Recreation.

Whereas, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five (5) days after its final passage and publication.
