AM ORDINANCE TRANSPEREING \$7000.00 FROM THE CONTINGENCY FUND TO THE CENERAL FUND FOR POLICE AND AMBULANCE SERVICE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Council determines that it is necessary for the general safety and centinued health of the citizens of Golden to provide increased ambulance and police service to the citizens on a 24-hour basis.

Section 2. In order to provide said increased services, it will be necessary to expend monles from the City General Fund.

Section 3. The decision by Council to increase the payment to the ambulance company and to add one additional officer to the Police force was made subsequent to the adoption of the 1970 budget, and therefore, it is necessary to transfer \$7,000.00 from the Contingency Fund.

Section 4. The City Hanager is, therefore, directed to transfer from the contingency fund the sum of \$7,000.00 and to appropriate in the General Fund the sum of \$7,000.00 for increased ambulance and police services for the year 1970.
