

ORDINANCE NO. 374

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEYS IN BLOCK 8, BOOTH'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GOLDEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That all alleys situate within Block (8) Booth's addition to the City of Golden, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado, be and the same are hereby vacated and abolished as public alleyways and thoroughfare.

Section 2. That there is reserved to the City of Golden, Colorado the right to enter said vacated alleyways for the purpose of installing, repairing and maintaining water and sewer lines, mains and connections.
