

**ORDINANCE NO. 221**

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF ARAPAHOE STREET, SOUTH GOLDEN.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:**

All that part and portion of Arapahoe Street, south of Clear Creek, in the City of Golden, Colorado, lying northwesterly of the northwesterly boundary line of Eleventh (11th) Street and a line extending across Arapahoe Street from a point on the southwesterly boundary line of Block D that is situate eighty (80) feet northwesterly from the northwesterly line of Eleventh (11th) Street to a point on the northwesterly boundary line of Block D½ that is situate seventy (70) feet northwesterly from the northwesterly boundary line of Eleventh (11th) Street, be and the same is hereby vacated and abolished as a public street, highway and intersection.
