## ORDINANCE NO. 215

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PERMITS TO TAP CITY MAINS AND AMENDING SECTION ONE (1) OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 194.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

SECTION 1: That Section One (1) of Ordinance Number 194 of said City of Golden is hereby amended to read as follows: From and after the passage and adoption of this Ordinance, a fee of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars shall accompany the application for the permit provided for and required by Section One (1) of Ordinance Number Eighteen (18) of said City, being Section 644, Revised Ordinances of 1937, and such permit shall not be issued unless said fee is paid and shall be issued only in the name of the owner of the real property involved.

SECTION 2: WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days after its final passage and publication.
