

550. Section 2. The vacation of that portion of said Fifteenth street and of said alleys is made subject to the right of said city to construct and maintain sanitary and storm sewers, or either thereof, in said alleys, forever; and also the city reserves the right to construct and maintain along the line of the vacated portion of said street a water main or mains; said vacation is also made upon the express condition that the said "School of Mines" shall construct and forever maintain a public driveway between the intersection of Maple and Fifteenth streets, and Illinois and Fifteenth streets aforesaid, providing that in case said "School of Mines" shall occupy any portion of said vacated street with a building, in that case said driveway may be constructed and maintained upon a line that shall not interfere with such building; and in case said "School of Mines" shall desire to erect a building upon said vacated street, then said water main or mains shall be constructed and maintained along the line of said driveway, and in case said "School of Mines" shall desire to erect a building or other structure or improvement upon the line of either of said alleys so vacated, then the city reserves the right to construct and maintain such sewers over and across said blocks or either thereof, on a line or lines to be agreed upon by the city and the board of trustees of said "School of Mines"; and if it shall become necessary to remove any water main or sewer main or mains, at any time, after the same has been laid by the city, in order to enable said "School of Mines" to carry out any improvement desired by the authorities thereof, then the expense of such change shall be borne by the said "School of Mines."

ORDINANCE NO. 92

(Passed March 7, 1924.)

Vacating Portion of Jackson Street, North Golden

560. Section 1. That that portion of Jackson street in the City of Golden, lying and situate between lot 10 block 23 and lot 1 in block 24, on the north side of Clear creek in the City of Golden, Jefferson county, Colorado, being that portion of said street lying southerly of the southerly line of Eighth street, formerly Wall street, in said city, and northerly of the northerly line of the alley running easterly and westerly through the center of said block 24 and the easterly half of said block 23, intersecting said street, be and the same is hereby vacated.

561. Section 2. That the fee of said portion of said Jackson street hereby vacated and all right, title and interest of the City of Golden or its inhabitants, or the public therein or of the state of Colorado or its inhabitants therein, shall be deemed and taken to vest in Coors Porcelain company, owner of said lots abutting on said vacated portion of said street hereby vacated, as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 114

(Passed September 4, 1925.)

Vacating Portion of Sixteenth and Birch Streets

562. Section 1. That that portion of Sixteenth Street in the City of Golden extending from the east line of Elm Street in said city, westerly to the western termination of said Sixteenth street, being approximately 998 feet along said street and that portion of Birch street in said city, extending from the northerly line of Sixteenth street in said city, southerly to the southerly termination of said Birch street, being approximately 640 feet along said street, be and the same are hereby vacated.
