

ORDINANCE NO. 371
AN ORDINANCE VACATING A
PORTION OF THE ALLEY IN
BLOCK 24 NORTH GOLDEN.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That all that portion of the alley in Block 24, North of Clear Creek in the City of Golden, Colorado, lying between lots (1) and twelve (12) thereof, be and the same is hereby vacated and abolished as a public alley and thoroughfare.

Section 2. The vacation of that portion of said alley as described in Section (1) hereof, is made subject to the right of said City of Golden to maintain, repair, construct and reconstruct any and all sanitary and storm sewers, water mains, conduits, hydrants, belonging to said City or connected to the water and sewer system thereof.
