ORDINANCE NO. 171

An Ordinance termed the Annual Appropriation Bill for the Fiscal Year Ending March 31, 1940.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, That the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, A. D. 1940, the following sums of money, as as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to defray the expenses and liabilities of the City of Golden, to-wit:

FIRST—Ten Thousand Dollars to provide for sinking funds, for the payment of the outstanding bonds of said City.

SECOND—Five Thousand Three Hundred Dollars, to pay the interest on the outstanding bonds of said City.

THIRD—Eight Thousand Two Hundred Twenty Dollars, to pay salaries, and Compensations of Officers of said City.

FOURTH—Five Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars, to construct and keep in repair the Streets, Alleys and Bridges, of said City together with Culverts, side-walks and Cross-walks. The Five Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars to be spent in the following manner:

A—Maintenance—\$3250.00.

B—W.P.A. Projects—\$1200.00.

C—Purchase of Grader—\$1250.00.

FIFTH—Nine Thousand Dollars, to pay the expenses of operating the Water Works of said City. The Nine Thousand Dollars to be spent in the following manner:

A—Maintenance—\$5200.00.

B—Purchase of Land—\$4300.00.

SIXTH—Twenty Eight Hundred Dollars, to pay the General and Incidental expenses of said City, not otherwise provided for.

SEVENTH—Twenty Five Hundred Dollars, to pay the expenses of the Police & Fire Department of said City.

EIGHTH—Twelve Hundred Dollars, to pay the expenses of the Golden Cemetery of said City.

NINTH—Five Hundred Dollars, to pay the expenses of RECREATION of said City.

TENTH—Twenty Nine Hundred Dollars, to pay the expenses of lighting the streets of said City.

ELEVENTH—One Thousand Dollars to pay State of Colorado for Liquor licenses issued by the City, and which had been spent by the City of Golden.
