

ORDINANCE NO. 238

AN ORDINANCE TERMED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING MARCH 31, 1949.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN:

That the fiscal year ending the 31st of March, A. D. 1949, the following sums of money, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to defray the expenses and liabilities of the City of Golden, to-wit:

First: \$100,613.03, To pay the water expenses of the said City. The total sum to be spent in the following manner.

- A. \$28,006.00, Maintenance.
- B. \$17,000.00, For the payment of the outstanding bonds of said City.
- C. \$3,841.68, To pay the interest on the outstanding bonds of said City.
- D. \$51,765.35, Water Extension.

Second: \$27,575.00, To construct and keep in repair the Streets, Alleys and Bridges, of said City, together with culverts, side-walks, and cross-walks. The total sum to be spent in the following manner.

- A. \$19,650.00, Maintenance.
- B. \$7,925.00, New street projects and equipment.

Third: \$24,284.50, To pay the expenses of the Police and Fire Departments of said City, as follows:

- A. Fire Department.
 - a. \$2,848.50, Maintenance.
 - b. \$8,200.00, Fire Department Sinking Fund.
- B. Police Department.
 - a. \$13,236.00, Maintenance.

Fourth: \$6,533.00, To pay the expenses of the Golden Park and Cemetery of said City.

Fifth: \$1,311.00, To pay the expenses of lighting the streets of said City.

Sixth: \$21,000.00, Is hereby appropriated for use during the fiscal year ending March 31, 1949, from the sewer fund created by Ordinances Number 191 and 192.

Seventh: \$13,510.00, To pay the General and Incidental expenses of said City, not otherwise provided for.

- A. \$9,760.00, Salaries.
- B. \$3,750.00, Maintenance.

Whereas, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days after its final passage and publication.
