

ORDINANCE NO. 888

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16.04 OF  
THE GOLDEN REVISED ORDINANCES OF 1965  
RELATING TO THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE;  
ADOPTING THE NATIONAL FIRE CODES BY  
REFERENCE THEREIN AND PRESCRIBING A  
PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 832 the City Council adopted the 1979 edition of the Uniform Fire Code; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend and update certain provisions thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Sections 16.04.010 of the Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965, as amended, is hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows:

16.04.010 Section 2.302 amended -  
Board of Adjustment. Delete the  
existing section and add the following  
section:

"Section 2.302. Board of Adjustment.  
The City's Board of Adjustment shall  
have jurisdiction to determine the  
suitability of alternate materials  
and type of construction and to pro-  
vide for reasonable interpretations  
of the provisions of this code."

Section 2. Section 16.04.012 of the Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965, as amended, is hereby enacted as follows:

"16.04.012 Section 2.303.5 added.  
Adoption by reference of National  
Fire Codes. Add a new section 2.303.5  
as follows:

Section 2.303.5 Adoption of National  
Fire Codes by reference. In addition  
to standards adopted herein by reference,  
the National Fire Codes, Volumes 1  
through 16, of the National Fire Pro-  
tection Association, Batterymarch  
Park, Quincy, Massachusetts 02269,  
1982 edition, are hereby adopted by  
reference as a part of this code as  
if set forth herein in full. Volumes  
1 through 12 of the National Fire  
Codes contain Codes and Standards which  
have been judged suitable for legal  
enforcement and Volumes 13 through 16  
contain recommended practices, manuals  
and guides which are generally referred  
to as good engineering practices."

Section 3. Penalty. The penalty for violation of any of the provisions of Volumes 1 through 12 of the National Fire Codes shall be as prescribed in Section 1.01.110 of the Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965, as amended.

Section 4. Copies of the National Fire Codes adopted herein by reference are available for inspection in the City Clerk's office.

Section 5. Any ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
