

ORDINANCE NO. 799

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC BY THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO; ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE 1977 EDITION OF THE "MODEL TRAFFIC CODE FOR COLORADO MUNICIPALITIES"; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Adoption. Pursuant to Title 31, Article 16, Parts 1 and 2, C.R.S. 1973, as amended, there is hereby adopted by reference Articles I to XXVI, inclusive, of the 1977 edition of the "Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities", promulgated and published as such by the State Department of Highways, 4201 E. Arkansas Ave., Denver, Colorado 80222. The subject matter of the Model Traffic Code relates primarily to comprehensive traffic control regulations for the City of Golden. The purpose of this ordinance and the Code adopted herein is to provide a system of traffic regulations consistent with state law and generally conforming to similar regulations throughout the state and the nation. Two (2) copies of the Model Traffic Code adopted herein are now filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Golden, Colorado, and may be inspected during regular business hours. The 1977 edition of the Model Traffic Code is adopted as if set out at length save and except the following articles and/or sections which are declared to be inapplicable to this municipality and are therefore expressly deleted.

Chapter 10 GAO
Section 2. Additions or Modifications. The said adopted Code is subject to the following additions or modifications:

a. Section 11-4 is hereby added, as follows:

"Sec. 11-4. Parking on private property-consent of person in legal control of property required.
(a) No person shall stop, stand or park any motor vehicle upon any private property of another without the consent of the owner, lessee, or person in legal possession or control of said property. For purposes of this section private property shall include public school lands.

(b) No citation shall issue for any violation of this chapter unless the owner, lessee, or person in legal possession or control of the private property whereon the vehicle is parked signs the citation as a complainant; provided, however, that when a vehicle is parked in an emergency access lane on private property, the signature of the owner, lessee, or person in legal possession or control of the property shall not be required."

b. Section 12-6 is hereby added, as follows:

"Sec. 12-6 Fire lanes. (a) The traffic engineer may designate specific areas of public land or land open to the public as a fire lane for the purpose of providing immediate access to a specified hazard area.

(b) No person, except a public officer acting with-
