

ORDINANCE NO. 926

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.24 OF THE  
GOLDEN REVISED ORDINANCES OF 1965, AND  
PROVIDING THAT THE MUNICIPAL COURT BECOME  
A COURT OF RECORD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN,  
COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 2.24.030 of the Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965, entitled "Appointment of Clerk and Deputy Clerks" is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Section 2.24.070 of the Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows:

"2.24.070 Assessment of Costs. The municipal judge shall be empowered in his discretion to assess costs against any defendant.

Section 3. The Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965, are hereby amended by the addition of Section 2.24.080 as follows:

"2.24.080 Court of Record. (1) The municipal court shall be a qualified municipal court of record and provision shall be made for the keeping of a verbatim record of the court proceedings and evidence at trial by electrical or electronic devices.

(2) It shall be the duty of the clerk of the municipal court, or her deputies, to provide transcripts of the proceedings in municipal court upon appeal. The appellant shall pay the clerk of the municipal court \$1.50 per page for each page of verbatim transcript so prepared, which fee shall be due and payable upon the preparation of said verbatim transcript."

Section 4. Any ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
