

ORDINANCE NO. 982

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$15,000 FROM
CONTINGENCY AND APPROPRIATING \$15,000 TO
THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN,
COLORADO:

Section 1. The City Council determines that certification by the City Manager shows there is available in Contingency a sum in excess of \$15,000.

Section 2. Since the adoption of the 1985 budget, Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to provide funds for an economic development program. An appropriation for said funds was not included in the 1985 budget.

Section 3. The cost associated with the aforementioned program will be paid from the Economic Development Program Fund.

Section 4. The City Manager is directed to transfer from Contingency the sum of \$15,000 and to appropriate \$15,000 to the Economic Development Program Fund, said transfer to occur within the budget for the calendar year of 1985.
