

ORDINANCE NO. 176

(Passed January 5, 1940)

**AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND DISPOSAL OF BLOCK 9,
GOLDEN PARK ADDITION**

Section 1. That all the right, title and interest of the City of Golden, Colorado, in and to the following described land, situated, lying and being in the County of Jefferson, and State of Colorado, be conveyed to O. L. Dennis, to-wit:

All of Block Nine (9), Golden Park Addition to the City of Golden.

Section 2. That Wilbur T. Shephard be and he hereby is appointed as Commissioner to make, execute and deliver such deeds or other instruments of conveyance as may be necessary or required in order to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 178

(Passed March 1, 1940)

**AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND DISPOSAL OF BLOCK 21,
WELCH'S ADDITION**

Section 1. That the City Council of said City be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey all the right, title and interest of said City in and to the following described land, situate, lying and being in the County of Jefferson, and State of Colorado, to-wit: All of Block 21, Welch's Addition to the City of Golden, for not less than the sum of \$6,000, cash, in hand paid, at the time of sale.

Section 2. That the City Clerk of the said City of Golden, be and he hereby is appointed as Commissioner to make, execute and deliver such deeds or other instruments of conveyance as may be necessary or required in order to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 179

(Passed April 5, 1940)

CREATING A POLICE DEPARTMENT.

Section 1. That the Police Department of the City of Golden, Colorado, shall consist of a chief of police, an assistant chief of police and such subordinate officers and members as the City Council shall or may deem necessary and required for the proper policing and the preservation of the peace and safety of said city.

Section 2. The members of said Police department, including the chief of police and assistant chief, shall be appointed by the City Council of said City for such term or terms, not exceeding one year, as the Council shall or may deem advisable or expedient.

Section 3. The City Council shall fix the compensation of the members
