

ORDINANCE NO.945

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$7,714 FROM
CONTINGENCY AND APPROPRIATING \$7,714 TO
THE CAPITAL PROGRAMS - CITY THOROUGHFARE
STUDY FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN,
COLORADO:

Section 1. The City Council determines that certification
by the City Manager shows there is available in Contingency a sum
in excess of \$7,714.00.

Section 2. Since the adoption of the 1983 budget, Council
has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to
provide funds for preliminary design for the Highway 93 by-pass.
An appropriation for said appraisal was not included in the 1983
budget.

Section 3. The cost associated with the aforementioned
appraisal will be paid from the Capital Programs - City
Thoroughfare Study Fund.

Section 4. The City Manager is directed to transfer from
Contingency the sum of \$7,714 and to appropriate \$7,714 to the
Capital Programs - City Thoroughfare Study Fund, said transfer to
occur within the budget for the calendar year of 1983.
