AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK ONE (1) ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF CLEAR CREEK IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That all that portion of the Alley described as follows, to-wit:

The alley lying to the rear of Lots One (1) to Twelve (12), inclusive, Block One (1) on the South Side of Clear Creek in the City of Golden, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado,

be and the same is hereby vacated and abolished as a public alleyway and thoroughfare, except that the City of Golden and other interested utility corporations shall be allowed to enter upon such alley to construct, reconstruct, repair or maintain sewers, telephone lines, telegraph lines, electric lines, gas mains, and water mains.
