

ORDINANCE NO. 213

AN ORDINANCE TERMED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING MARCH 31, 1945.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, That the Fiscal year ending the 31st of March, A. D. 1945, the following sums of money, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to defray the expenses and liabilities of the City of Golden, to-wit:

First: Seventeen Thousand and No/100 Dollars, to provide for sinking funds, for the payment of the outstanding bonds of said City.

Second: Four Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Three and 87/100 Dollars to pay the interest on the outstanding bonds of said City.

Third: Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Five and No/100 Dollars, to pay salaries and compensations of the officers of said City.

Fourth: Nine Thousand and No/100 Dollars, to construct and keep in repair the Streets, Alleys and Bridges, of said City, together with culverts, Side-walks, and Cross-walks. The total sum to be spent in the following manner:

A. One Thousand and No/100 Dollars for Street Paving.

B. Eight Thousand and No/100 Dollars for Street Maintenance.

Fifth: Fourteen Thousand nine Hundred Fifty and No/100 Dollars, to pay the Water expenses of said City. The total sum to be spent in the following manner:

A. Seven Thousand and No/100 Dollars for the Bentoniting of Beaver Brook Reservoir.

B. Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty and No/100 Dollars for Water Maintenance.

Sixth: Four Thousand and No/100 Dollars, to pay the General and Incidental expenses of said city, not otherwise provided for. Total sum to be spent in the following manner:

A. General and Incidental Expenses, Three Thousand and No/100 Dollars.

B. One Thousand and No/100 Dollars for the planning of projects.

Seventh: Five Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Dollars, to pay the expenses of the Police and Fire Departments of said City, as follows:

A. Fire Department Expenses \$ 600.00
 B. Sinking Fund for Fire Truck \$2,750.00
 C. Police Department \$2,500.00

Eighth: One Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars, to pay the expenses of the Golden Park and Cemetery of said City.

A. Cemetery \$750.00
 B. Park Expenses \$750.00

Ninth: One Thousand Seven Hundred Forty two and No/100 Dollars, to pay the expenses of lighting the streets of said City.

Tenth: There is hereby appropriated, for use during the fiscal year ending March 31, 1946, from the sewer fund created by Ordinances Number 191 and 192 the sum of Two Thousand and No/100 Dollars.

Whereas, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days after its final passage and publication.
