BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, That the Fiscal year ending the 31st of March, A. D. 1945, the following sums of money, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to defray the excpnses and liabilities of the City of Golden, to-wit:
