

ORDINANCE NO. 653

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PARKING ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN AS IT RELATES TO
PARALLEL PARKING WITHIN THE CITY AND ESTAB-
LISHING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE
ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 10.68.010 (d), is hereby amended to change the (d) to (b).

Section 10.68.010 of Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby amended
by the addition of the following subsection:

c. Obedience to designated areas. Every person parking parallel to
either the left hand curb or the right hand curb where parking is permitted shall
park the vehicle within the areas indicated by such signs or markings as have
been established by the traffic engineer or person authorized to establish said
markings. No person shall park outside of the area designated for an individual
automobile if said area has been identified by markings on the street or by
appropriate signs on the adjacent curb.

Section 3. Violation. Any person violating the provisions of this
Ordinance shall be punished as is provided in Section 1.01.110, Golden Revised
Ordinances of 1965 which provides for a fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more
than \$300.00, or by imprisonment not to exceed 90 days in the County jail, or by
both such fine and imprisonment.
