

ORDINANCE NO. 776

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF 17TH
STREET LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF GOLDEN

WHEREAS, a portion of 17th Street lying between East Street and the Welch Ditch, although dedicated, has never been maintained as a public street; and

WHEREAS, all the owners of land adjacent to said undeveloped portion of 17th Street have consented to and approved of the proposed vacation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That a portion of 17th Street located within the City of Golden and more specifically described as

that portion of 17th Street lying between the easterly right of way line of East Street and the westerly right of way line of the Welch Ditch, City of Golden, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street and thoroughfare with an easement reserved over, across, under and upon said vacated street for the installation, repair and maintenance of utilities and appurtenances thereto.

"8.16.010 Creation, appointment, terms. There is created a city planning commission for the City of Golden which commission shall be comprised of seven members each of whom shall be a resident of the city.

The seven members of the commission shall be appointed by the mayor of the city, the appointment of whom shall be confirmed by a majority of the council. All members of the commission shall serve without compensation, unless the council shall by resolution establish a compensation and shall not hold any other municipal office, except that one of the members may be a member of the board of adjustment.

The terms of the members of the commission shall be for a period of four years or until their successor takes office, except that the initial appointments made during 1972 wherein four members shall be appointed, two members shall be appointed for two years and two members shall be appointed for four years and the members of the present planning commission shall serve to the expiration of their present terms.

Alternates to the commission shall be appointed at large by the mayor with the concurrence of a majority of the council for four year terms and in such numbers and from time to time as the mayor and council deem appropriate. Alternates shall sit in the absence of regularly appointed commission members."

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
