

ORDINANCE NO. 335
An Ordinance termed the Additional
Appropriation Bill for the fiscal
year ending December 31, 1952.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GOLDEN, COLORADO:

That Ordinance No. 325 of the City of Golden, termed the Annual Appropriation Bill for the Fiscal Year Ending December 31, 1952, provided for the following appropriated sums of money to pay the water and sewer expenses of the said City:

A. \$23,937.50, Water Maintenance. Whereas, the foregoing appropriation has been found to be inadequate to meet the requirements of the aforesaid operation of the said City Government, to-wit:

1. Water Maintenance in the amount of \$1,681.69.

And Whereas, the Water and Sewer Utility Fund unappropriated surplus has been estimated to have a surplus of \$107.22 over and above the anticipated expenditures for the balance of the Fiscal Year ending December 31, 1952.

That Ordinance No. 325 further provided for the following appropriated sums of money to pay the General and incidental expenses of the said City, not otherwise provided for:

B. \$20,500.00, Police Department Maintenance.
C. \$22,496.98, To construct and keep in repair the streets, alleys, and bridges, of said City, together with culverts, sidewalks, and crosswalks.

Whereas, the foregoing appropriations have been found to be inadequate to meet the requirements of the aforesaid operations of the said City Government, to-wit:

2. Police Department Maintenance in the amount of \$1,493.10.
3. Street Department Maintenance in the amount of \$2,878.19.

And Whereas, the General Fund unappropriated surplus has been estimated to have a surplus of \$15,000.00 over and above the anticipated expenditures for the balance of the Fiscal Year ending December 31, 1952.

And Whereas, the amounts of the respective requested transfers of funds are less than the anticipated expenditures of the funds having a surplus together with the requested transfers, the City Council of the said City upon request of the Budget Authority, hereby authorizes and orders the following transfers of funds to the designated departments as follows, to-wit:

1. Water Maintenance in the amount of \$1,681.69.
2. Police Department Maintenance in the amount of \$1,493.10.
3. Street Department Maintenance in the amount of \$2,878.19.

And Whereas, in the opinion of the City Council an emergency exists, and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five (5) days after its final passage and publication.
