ORDINANCE NO. 196

**AMENDING SECTION 2 OF
ORDINANCE NO. 186**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GOLDEN, COLORADO:**

Section 1: That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 186, of said City of Golden, Colorado, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The Compensation of Special Police and of Laborers employed by the City shall be fixed by the City Council, and may be changed, from time to time, in its discretion."

Section 2: Whereas, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days after its final passage and publication.
