AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF 11TH STREET EAST OF FORD STREET, CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Adolph Coors Company has made application for vacation of a portion of 11th Street east of Ford Street in the City of Golden; and

WHEREAS, public hearings on the vacation have been held before the Planning Commission and the City Council and the application is complete and in accordance with the vacation procedures and regulations of the City of Golden.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Eleventh Street east of Ford Street, City of Golden, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado, as the same is more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street and right-of-way, subject to the retention of a utility easement under and across the vacated right-of-way. Said retained easement is more particularly described in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Any ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EXHIBIT "B"

20-foot Storm Sewer Easeement

That portion of the South West Quarter of Section 27, Township 3 South, Range 70 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, City of Golden, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado, the centerline of said easement being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the West Quarter corner of said Section 27, Township 3 South, Range 70 West of the 6th Principal Meridian;

Thence South 19°28'50"East a distance of 1673.02 feet to a point on the Easterly right of way line of Ford Street, said point, also, being the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

Thence North 44°56'59"East, a distance of 15.32 feet;

Thence North 48°26'03"East, a distance of 151.82 feet;

Thence North 23°16'49"East, a distance of 12.35 feet to the POINT OF TERMINUS, from which said point bears South 25°17'13"East, a distance of 1608.52 feet from the West Quarter of said Section 27. Said property and easement being as illustrated on Exhibit C attached hereto. Parcel contains 3590 square feet (.082 AC.).
