

ORDINANCE NO. 808

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR MARKING AND
ENTRY OF EXHIBITS IN HEARINGS WHERE CITY
COUNCIL AND OTHER BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS
SIT IN A QUASI-JUDICIAL CAPACITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965, as amended, are hereby amended by the addition of Section 1.01.118, as follows:

"1.01.118 Exhibits and Instruments-Marking.
At each City Council, Board of Adjustment, or Planning Commission hearing, or other Board or Commission of the City of Golden, wherein the respective body sits in a quasi-judicial capacity, the City Clerk shall mark as exhibits, all instruments, documents, staff comments, and maps distributed to the Council, Board or Commission prior to such hearing, and shall likewise mark as exhibits all pleadings, applications evidence, exhibits, staff comments, and other papers presented to or considered by the Council, Board or Commission, at such hearing, all of which shall be received into evidence at such hearing without motion or order or ruling of the Chair."

Section 2. All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
