

ORDINANCE NO. 384

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 59, SOUTH OF CLEAR CREEK, CITY OF GOLDEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That all that portion of the alley within Block 59 on the South side of Clear Creek, in the City of Golden, lying between lots 9 and 10 in said block, be and is hereby vacated as a public way and thoroughfare.

Section 2. That there is reserved hereby to the City of Golden, an easement and right of way for the installation and maintenance of sewer and water mains, lines and appurtenances thereto, in, upon and over the aforesaid portion of alley hereby vacated.
