## ORDINANCE NO. 220

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AND REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

SECTION 1. Definitions. As used

in this Ordinance, the terms:
"Standard Type Sidewalk" is defined and shall be interpreted to mean a sidewalk constructed and laid with the inside line thereof one foot from the abutting lot or property line;

"Curb Type Sidewalk" is defined and shall be interpreted to mean a sidewalk laid and constructed immediately adjacent to and adjoining the curb.

SECTION 2. Sidewalks hereafter constructed and laid shall conform to the following specifications:

(a) sidewalks may be either of the standard type or curb type, as above defined.

sidewalks of the standard (b) type shall be so laid that the inside line thereof shall be one foot from the abutting lot or property line and shall be five feet in width, pro-vided that the City Council may, by resolution, authorize the construcbut in no event shall the width of such sidewalk as so authorized, be

less than four feet.
(c) sidewalks of the curb type, shall be five feet in width exclusive of the width of the curb, provided that the City Council may, by resolution, authorize the construction of curb type sidewalks of lesser width, but in no event shall the width of such sidewalk as so authorized, be less than four feet, ex-clusive of the width of the curb. SECTION 3. Sidewalks of only

one type, as above defined, shall be laid and constructed along the same side of a block. All sidewalks laid and constructed after the effective date of this ordinance shall con-form in type, as above defined and in construction, with sidewalks, laid, constructed and existing on the effective date of this ordinance. provided, that the type and construction of any sidewalk, whether the same is constructed and in place at the time this Ordinance takes effect, or laid and laid and constructed thereafter, may be changed upon the mutual agreement and consent of the owners of all lots to be atfected and upon the filing of a petition with the City Council, signed by all of the owners of lots to be affected by such change, requesting authority to change the type of side-walk then existini. The City Council, upon consideration of said peti-tion and upon written order, may

either grant or deny the same. SECTION 4. Curb type sidewalks shall not be constructed on curbs having a height of more than 8 inches, nor at locations or sites where alleys or similar curb cuts are of such grades that would ren-der the construction of curb type sidewalks dangerous to pedestrian traffic.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
