

ORDINANCE NO. 36

(Passed December 5, 1899.)

488. Section 1. No person shall ride a bicycle or tricycle, or push or draw a handcar or wheelbarrow along and upon any sidewalk or crosswalk situate on any street or avenue within the limits of this city.

489. Section 2. No person shall coast, slide, skate or ride, whether by sled, sleigh, wagon or other vehicle, or in any other manner, along and upon any sidewalk or crosswalk situate on any street or avenue within the limits of this city.

490. Section 3. No person shall drive, lead or ride any horse or other draft animal or animals, with or without vehicle attached, or any meat cattle, or draw or back any wagon, cart, carriage, sled or sleigh, over or upon any sidewalk situate on any street or avenue within the limits of this city, except at the alley or street crossing thereof, or other place where a crossing place has been provided.

491. Section 4. No person shall occupy any crosswalk on the streets and alleys of this city, or any private crossing over the sidewalks upon the streets and avenues of this city, by any animal or vehicle, or both attached, a longer time than may be necessary to cross the same.

492. Section 5. Any person violating or causing to be violated any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars.
