

ORDINANCE NO. 309

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 4, PARFET'S SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the alley as platted on the Map of the City of Golden, in Block 4, Parfet's Subdivision, is hereby vacated and abolished as a public alley and thoroughfare.

Section 2. The vacation of the alley herein made subject to the rights of the said City and all public utilities to maintain, repair, construct, and reconstruct, any and all sanitary and storm sewers or either thereof, belonging to the said City or connected to the sewer system thereof, and all conduits, hydrants, pipelines and accessories or either thereof added to or connected with the Water System of said City of Golden, or connected with or necessary to the public utilities systems now or hereafter located within and serving the City of Golden.
