

ORDINANCE NO. 182

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF EIGHTH STREET AND A PORTION OF THE INTERSECTION OF EIGHTH STREET AND JACKSON STREET IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COUNTY OF JEFFERSON AND STATE OF COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COUNTY OF JEFFERSON AND STATE OF COLORADO:

FIRST: That all of that portion of 8th street, situate, lying and being between the center line of said Street and the Northerly boundary line of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 in Block 24 and Lots 10, 11 and 12 in Block 23, on the North side of Clear Creek in said City of Golden, which line is also the Southerly boundary line of said 8th street, and all of the Southerly Half of the intersection of said 8th Street and Jackson Street be and the same are and each and every part and portion thereof is hereby vacated and abolished as a public street, thoroughfare and intersection, and the fee thereof and all right, title and interest of the State of Colorado, or of its inhabitants, or of the City of Golden, or its inhabitants, or of the public, shall be deemed and taken to vest, and the same is hereby vested, as provided by law, in CCORS PORCELAIN COMPANY, the owner of all the Lots, to-wit: Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of said Block 24 and Lots 10, 11 and 12 of said Block 23, abutting on said vacated portion of 8th Street and said vacated portion of said intersection of 8th and Jackson Streets.

SECOND: WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days after its final publication.
