## ORDINANCE NO. 224

AN ORDINANCE TERMED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING MARCH 31, 1948.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOL-DEN, COLORADO:

That the Fiscal Year ending the alst of March, A. D. 1948, the fol-lowing sums of money, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to defray the expenses and liabilities of the City

of Golden, to-wit: First: \$17,060.60 to provide for sinking funds, for the payment of the outstanding bonds of said City.

Second: \$2,759.04 to pay the interest on the outstanding bonds of said City.

Third: \$22,889.75 to pay the water

Third: \$22,889.15 to pay the water expenses of said City. Fourth: \$14,751.00 to construct and keep in repair the Streets, Alleys and Bridges, of said City, together with culverts, side-walks and cross-walks.

Fifth: \$19,687,00 to pay the ex-penses of the Fire and Police de-partments of said City, as follows:

 A. Fire Department.
A. \$1,865.00 Maintenance.
B. \$6,600.00 Fire Department Sinking Fund. B. Police Department,

A. \$11,222.00. Sixth: \$6.533.50 \$6,533.50 to pay the expenses of the Golden Park and Cemevery of said City:

A. Park Expense.

A. \$1,790.00.

B. Cemetery Expense.

A. \$4,743.50. Seventh: \$1,742.00 to pay the expenses of lighting the streets of said City. Eighth:

\$17,675.00 is hereby appropriated for use during the fiscal year ending March 31, 1948, from the sewer fund created by Ordinances

Number 191 and 192. Ninth: \$6,870.00 to pay the Gen-eral and incidental expenses of said City, not otherwise provided for.

Whereas, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the ex-piration of five days after its final passage and publication. Introduced and read this 23rd day
