ORDINANCE NO. 770

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING UNANTICIPATED AND UNENCUMBERED MONIES TO THE FIRE STATION NO. 3 ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, the City of Golden has received \$3,600.00 from the sale of property and said \$3,600.00 was not budgeted or appropriated as part of the 1976 budget, and

WHEREAS, the City of Golden desires to purchase the property on which Fire Station No. 3 is located plus a driveway into said station at a total cost of \$4,909.35.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Council determines that certification by the City Manager shows that there are available unencumbered funds in the amount of \$3,600.00 resulting from the sale of property, plus an available fund balance in the Fire Station No. 3 account.

Section 2. The City Manager is directed to transfer these unencumbered funds to the Fire Station No. 3 account for the purchase of the desired property.
