## ORDINANCE NO. 204

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SOUTH CURB LINE AND THE SOUTH BOUNDARY LINE OF DE-POT STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1: That the SOUTH CURB LINE of Depot Street is hereby fixed

Section 1: That the SOUTH CURB LINE of Depot Street is hereby fixed and established as follows, to-wit:
Beginning at a point, on the East line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 27. Township 3, South, Range 70, West of the 6th P.M. which is 70-4/10 feet due south of the Northeast corner of said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 27, thence N. 46° 40′ E, magnetic, a distance of 928.85 feet, to an iron pipe which is 268 feet northly from the point of intersection of the East boundary line of Archer Street with the centerline of 10th Street.

Section 2: That the SOUTH BOUNDARY LINE of Depot Street is hereby fixed and established as a line exactly Five (5) Feet South of The South Curb Line described in Section 1 hereof, throughout its entire length.
