

ORDINANCE NO. 512

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CERTAIN TYPE SIGNS TO BE SUSPENDED BELOW COVERED WALKWAYS IN C-2 ZONED AREAS IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO, AND AMENDING SECTION 4508 OF ORDINANCE 434 OF THE SAID CITY OF GOLDEN, AND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 458 OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 4508H of Ordinance 434 as passed by Ordinance 458 of the said City of Golden is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4508. Covered Walkways.

H. The following sign regulations shall pertain to permissive signs which may be mounted below a covered walkway and are supported by said covered walkway. Projecting signs, wall mounted, shall not be allowed below any such covered walkway.

1. Clearance Above Sidewalk. A covered walkway sign shall have not less than 8' 6" nor more than 9' 0" clearance above the sidewalk.

2. Clearance from Building Front Wall. A covered walkway hung sign shall have its in-board edge not less than eleven inches nor more than thirteen inches from the building front wall.

3. Length of Sign. A covered walkway hung sign shall have a length of not less than 40 inches nor more than 48 inches.

4. Height of Sign. A covered walkway hung sign shall have a height of not less than four inches nor more than twelve inches.

5. Thickness of Sign. A covered walkway hung sign shall have a thickness not to exceed

2½ inches.

6. Lighting of Sign. Covered Walkway signs shall not be internally illuminated nor have attached lighting components. Indirect illumination shall be permissible provided such lighting is in a manner as to shield the street from lighting glare.

7. Number of Signs. One sign per building entrance may be installed (rear doors shall not be classified as a building entrance for the purposes of these regulations).

8. Text on Sign. The following information may be placed on a covered walkway sign:

A. Name of store or business.
B. Identification of store or business by product and/or service (trade names or brands shall not be used).
C. Identification or association symbols.

9. Sign Permit. A sign permit shall be procured from the City of Golden, Colorado, prior to the hanging of a covered walkway sign.

10. No sign other than that referred to above shall be attached to or supported by any part of a covered walkway.

Section 2. Whereas, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days after its final passage and publication.
