

ORDINANCE NO. 875

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$50,000.00 FROM
CONTINGENCY AND APPROPRIATING \$50,000.00
TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN,
COLORADO:

Section 1. The City Council determines that certification by the City Manager shows there is available in Contingency a sum in excess of \$50,000.00.

Section 2. Since the adoption of the 1981 budget, Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to convert certain city vehicles from gasoline to natural gas. This conversion will necessitate the purchase of a cascade, a compressor, plus installation costs. An appropriation for said conversion was not included in the 1981 budget.

Section 3. The costs associated with the aforementioned conversion will be paid from the budget of the Police Department.

Section 4. The City Manager is directed to transfer from Contingency the sum of \$50,000.00 and to appropriate \$50,000.00 to the Police Department, said transfer to occur within the budget for the calendar year, 1981.
