## ORDINANCE NO. 383

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF ILLINOIS STREET IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That all that portion of Illinois street lying Northerly and Westerly of Fourth Street, be and the same is noreby vacated as a public street, way and thoroughfare.

Section 2. There is hereby reserved to the City of Golden, in that portion of Illinois Street above described, the right to lay, install, maintain, and repair, sewer and water mains and appurtenances, as may be required.
