ORDINANCE NO. 684

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$2,420.70 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS AND APPROPRIATING \$2,420.70 FOR TAXES DUE ON THE TRACT OF LAND KNOWN AS THE POST OFFICE SITE LOCATED IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO AND TRANSFERRING \$2,000.00 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS AND APPROPRIATING \$2,000.00 FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE ASTOR HOUSE IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY CCUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLCRADO:

Section 1. Pursuant to the sale agreement set forth in Ordinance No. 679, which received final City Council approval on December 14, 1972, the City of Golden agreed to provide marketable title to the condemned post office property for the contract purchaser.

Section 2. The County Treasurer of Jefferson County, Colorado, has notified the City of Golden that \$2,420.70 in taxes, delinquent taxes and interest on delinquent taxes is due on the condemned post office property. It is necessary to transfer \$2,420.70 from unappropriated surplus and appropriate \$2,420.70 from the general fund for payment of the City's obligations concerning taxes due and payable on the condemned post office property.

Section 3. The City Council has agreed to appropriate \$2,000.00 for capital improvements to the Astor House to be done by the Golden Landmarks Association under control and supervision of the City Manager. It is necessary to transfer \$2,000.00 from unappropriated surplus and appropriate \$2,000.00 from the general fund for capital improvements for the Astor House.

Section 4. The City Manager is directed to transfer from unappropriated surplus the sum of \$4,420.70 and to appropriate from the general fund \$2,420.70 for taxes due on the condemned post office property and \$2,000.00 for capital improvements for the Astor House.
