

ORDINANCE NO. 413

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO, AND FIXING WATER AND SEWER RATES AND CHARGES AND REPEALING SECTIONS 1, 2, 6 AND 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 360.

WHEREAS, the 1958 Fiscal year is lacking in Water Revenues in the amount of \$19,770.00, and

WHEREAS, the Water supply facilities need major improvements which are recommended by the Colorado State Health Department, and

WHEREAS, sewer mains are being overloaded and becoming inadequate to serve Golden through its current period of growth, and

WHEREAS, the existing water and sewer revenues are inadequate to meet these costs and have the water and sewer utility fund remain self-supporting, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the following water and sewer rates be put into full effect and force on January 1, 1958, as the basis for charging users of the water and sewer utility system during the quarter ending on March 31, 1958, and thereafter.

Section 2. There is hereby established a Water Rate Schedule I which shall apply to all water delivered to domestic or commercial users within the City limits of Golden quarterly billed on the 1st days of January, April, July and October, except as billed under Section 3 hereof:

WATER RATE SCHEDULE I

Quarterly Minimum — See Table I (including 9,000 gallons)
 Next 15,000 gallons at 50 cents per thousand gallons
 Next 75,000 gallons at 45 cents per thousand gallons
 Next 120,000 gallons at 40 cents per thousand gallons

All usage in excess of 219,000 gallons at 36 cents per thousand gallons.

Section 3. There is hereby established Water Rate Schedule II which shall apply to all water delivered to residents of single family dwellings within the City limits of Golden during the months of April through December inclusive as quarterly billed on the 1st days of July, October and January:

WATER RATE SCHEDULE II

Quarterly Minimum — See Table I (including 9,000 gallons)
 Next 15,000 gallons at 40 cents per thousand gallons
 Next 60,000 gallons at 30 cents per thousand gallons
 Next 75,000 gallons at 45 cents per thousand gallons
 Next 120,000 gallons at 40 cents per thousand gallons

All usage in excess of 279,000 gallons at 36 cents per thousand gallons.

Section 4. There is hereby established a Water Rate Schedule III which shall apply to all water used solely for irrigation within the City Limits and delivered to the Consumer through a separate irrigation meter and tap during the months of April through December inclusive as quarterly billed on the 1st days of July, October and January:

WATER RATE SCHEDULE III

Quarterly Minimum — See Table I (including 9,000 gallons)
 All usage in excess of 9,000 gallons at

30 cents per thousand gallons.

Section 5. There is hereby established Water Rate Schedule IV which shall apply to all water delivered to domestic, commercial, or irrigational users outside the City limits of Golden, except as provided for in Section 6, billed on the 1st days of April, July, October and January of each year:

WATER RATE SCHEDULE IV

Quarterly Minimum — See Table II (including 9,000 gallons)
 Next 15,000 gallons at \$1.00 per thousand gallons
 Next 75,000 gallons at \$.90 per thousand gallons
 Next 120,000 gallons at \$.80 per thousand gallons

All usage in excess of 219,000 gallons at 72 cents per thousand gallons.

Section 6. There is hereby established Water Rate Schedule V which shall apply to water delivered to the Pleasant View Water and Sanitation District during all months of the year as quarterly billed on the 1st days of April, July, October and January of each year:

WATER RATE SCHEDULE V

Quarterly Minimum — See Table II (including 9,000 gallons)
 Next 15,000 gallons at 62 cents per thousand gallons
 Next 75,000 gallons at 56 cents per thousand gallons
 Next 120,000 gallons at 50 cents per thousand gallons
 All usage in excess of 219,000 gallons at 45 cents per thousand gallons.

Section 7. There is hereby established Table I relating to Minimum Quarterly Charges for uses within the City limits, which table is based upon the size of meter installed as a measure of available water to each user. A meter installed in a service line shall be of a size commensurate with the delivery capacity of the service line; a maximum difference of a single increment of pipe diameter will be permissible.

Section 8. There is hereby established Table II relating to Minimum Quarterly Charges for uses outside the City limits, which table is based upon the size of meter installed as a measure of available water to each user. A meter installed in a service line shall be of a size commensurate with the delivery capacity of the service line; a maximum difference of a single increment of pipe diameter will be permissible:

Section 9. There is hereby established a charge for the availability of water for the purpose of fire protection by means of an un-metered sprinkler system—A rate of 50 cents per thousand square feet of total floor area protected per quarter. Where such fire protection systems are metered by a meter in the service line to the premises protected through which all water use is so metered the above rate shall not apply.

Section 10. There is hereby established a charge for construction water used by a contractor erecting a new building, except a residential accessory building, as follows:

Residential Building — Single family or duplex occupancy	\$15.00
All other construction	40.00

This charge is in lieu of a metered water charge.

Section 11. All water delivered and all services rendered in connection therewith, shall be paid for as in this ordinance set forth, provided however, that in no case shall the charge for water supplied and measured by meter, be less than the proper minimum quarterly charge set forth in Table I and Table II herein, except that in the event of termination of service where advance notice thereof is given to the Water Department, the amount due will be the quarterly minimum charge or the amount computed by multiplying the metered amount of water consumed as of date of notice of termination by the appropriate rate specified herein which ever is greater, together with the charge of \$1.50 for turning off the water. A service charge of \$1.50 shall likewise be paid for turning on water at such premises.

Section 12. Each service line will be charged a minimum charge as set forth in Table I or Table II unless such service line is shut off, and a fee paid as provided.

Section 13. There is hereby established Sewer Rate Schedule VI, which schedule shall set the charges for the use of the sanitary sewers and sewage system by all users in the City of Golden as quarterly billed on the 1st day of January, April, July and October; subject to maximum quarterly charges set forth in Section 14 hereof;

SEWER RATE SCHEDULE VI
Minimum quarterly fee \$3.00
Charge for sewage in excess of 18,000 gallons—1/6th of the charge set forth herein for all such water used in excess of 18,000 gallons.

Section 14. There is hereby established a maximum sewer charge for all residential users of the sanitary sewers and sewage system as follows:

A. Single Family Residential Users—The sewer charge as determined by use of Schedule VI as quarterly billed on the 1st day of April shall become the maximum sanitary sewer charge for each quarterly billing as the 1st day of July, and October of the same calendar year and January of the following calendar year. In case the water usage declines in the latter quarters so that the charge so determined by use of Schedule VI is less than that charge of April 1, the lesser charge shall apply except in no case shall the charge be less than \$3.00 per quarter.

B. Other Residential Users—The sewer charge as determined by the use of Schedule VI as quarterly billed on the 1st day of April multiplied by a factor of one and one-quarter shall become the maximum sanitary sewer charge for each quarterly billing on the 1st day of July and October of the same calendar year, and January of the following calendar year. In case that the charge determined by use of Schedule VI is less than that of April 1, the lesser charge shall apply except in no case shall the charge be less than \$3.00 per quarter.

C. No sewer charge shall be made under this section for irrigation water which is metered separately and used solely for irrigation pursuant to Section 4 hereof.

Section 15. The City may extend the use of its sewage system beyond the corporate limits of the City and in such cases the rates and charges for such service shall be double the rates and charges set forth in Schedule VI. Where such use is extended beyond the City Limits, and such user makes no use of City water, the applicable sewer charge shall be determined by the Council.

Section 16. Sections 1, 2, 6 and 7, of Ordinance 360 of the City of Golden are hereby repealed and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 17. Whereas, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five (5) days after its final passage and publication.
