

ORDINANCE NO. 455

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PART OF 19TH STREET LYING IN PARTIAL BLOCK "D", KINNEY'S AND WELCH'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COUNTY OF JEFFERSON, STATE OF COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the Southeasterly 18 inches of that part of 19th Street lying between the Easterly line of Ford Street and the Westerly line of the Northwesterly-Southeasterly alley lying in partial Block "D", Kinney's and Welch's Addition to the City of Golden, be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street and thoroughfare.
