

ORDINANCE NO. 306

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK ONE (1) ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF CLEAR CREEK IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 287 OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the alley as plat-
ted on the Map of the City of Gol-
den, Colorado, is hereby vacated
and abolished as a public alley and
thorofare.

Section 2. That Ordinance No.
287, of the City of Golden, Colorado,
is hereby repealed.
