RESOLUTION NO. 1172

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO APPROVING THE REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT FROM AND CERTIFICATION OF USE OF FUNDS TO JEFFERSON COUNTY OPEN SPACES FOR: (1) PAVING CLEAR CREEK TRAIL UNDER THE FORD STREET BRIDGE(2) IMPROVEMENTS TO GOLDEN HEIGHTS PARK (3) CONSTRUCTION OF THE IN LINE HOCKEY RINK.

WHEREAS, the trail under the Ford Street Bridge, north side of Clear Creek is in process; and

WHEREAS, the development of Golden Heights Park is complete; and

WHEREAS, the construction of the In Line Hockey Rink is complete; and

WHEREAS, the City of Golden now seeks reimbursement of Jefferson County Open Space Joint Venture Grant Funds of \$342,853.92.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1: Clear Creek Trail – The Golden City Council certifies that as of 31 December 2000, the City of Golden has expended \$204,082 for the paving of trails on the north side of Clear Creek and is hereby requesting reimbursement for \$100,000, which in accordance with the requirements of this Jefferson County Open Space Joint Venture Grant, is equal to 49% of the total project expenditures.

Section 2: Golden Heights Park - The Golden City Council certifies that as of 31 December 2000, the City of Golden has expended \$213,234.53 for the construction of the Golden Heights Park and is hereby requesting reimbursement for \$104,484.92 which, in accordance with the requirements of this Jefferson County Open Space Joint Venture Grant, is equal to 49% of the total project expenditures.

Section 3: In Line Hockey Rink - The Golden City Council certifies that as of 31 December 2000, the City of Golden has expended \$282,385 for the construction of the In Line Hockey Rink and is hereby requesting reimbursement for \$138,369 which, in accordance with the requirements of this Jefferson County Open Space Joint Venture Grant, is equal to 49% of the total project expenditures
