A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL  
SUPPORTING THE DENVER REGIONAL COUNCIL OF  
GOVERNMENTS BOARD RESOLUTION 23 WHICH SEEKS AN  
EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION OF STATE TRANSPORTATION  
FUNDING

WHEREAS, the DRCOG Board of Directors by its Resolution Number 23 calls Colorado's attention to the inequitable distribution of state transportation funding and proposes a more equitable distribution formula; and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Quadrant Feasibility Study determined that the future mobility of area residents requires a multitude of highway corridor improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Golden City Council recognizes that mobility improvements are needed even more desperately in other areas of the Denver metropolitan region; and


WHEREAS, the Golden City Council supports the Denver Regional Council of Governments and is committed to fair and equitable use of tax dollars.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:


Section 1. The Council supports the DRCOG Board Resolution Number 23.

Section 2. The Council directs its representative to the DRCOG Board to continue to support the efforts for equitable distribution of state transportation funding.




