A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL PERTAINING TO A SETBACK VARIANCE AT 1904 SAGE DRIVE

WHEREAS, Bob DeCamp 1904 Sage Drive, Golden CO. 80401 has applied for a variance from the requirements of the Golden Municipal Code for property located at 1904 Sage Drive; and

WHEREAS, a Special Hearing has been requested of City Council as permitted under section 18.12.030(1)(d); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 18.12.045 of the Golden Municipal Code, City Council held a Special Hearing on September 11, 2003 and considered evidence and testimony presented in favor and in opposition to the request.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. City Council finds that the variance request does not comply with the criteria in Chapter 18.12.030 of the Golden Municipal Code pertaining to a hardship in complying with the current code.

Section 2. City Council finds from the testimony that such relief if granted may cause substantial detriment to public good, and will alter the essential character of the neighborhood.

Section 3. On the basis of these findings, City Council denies the requested variance to allow a thirteen (13) foot side setback for the existing storage shed.
