**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING
SCULPTURES**

WHEREAS, this public art will enhance the community and the downtown; and

WHEREAS, this art is placed in public places to benefit the community.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO THAT:


The City Council accepts the dedication of the "LITTLE BOY FISHIN" sculpture placed in the City right of way along Clear Creek trail behind the Visitors Center, the "2 DEER" sculptures placed along the Clear Creek trail behind the Police Department, the "BEAR AND 2 CUBS" sculptures placed along the Clear Creek trail north of the Living History Park, and the "LITTLE GIRL IN VICTORIAN DRESS" sculpture placed by the Friendship Garden on the south side of Billy Drew Bridge, placed December 3, 2004, agree to maintain the area where these sculptures were placed and provide insurance coverage of the artwork.




