**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL REGARDING
THE CITY OF GOLDEN'S 150TH ANNIVERSARY**

WHEREAS, Golden has enjoyed a rich and colorful history, including a long history of habitation by the Ute, Cheyenne, and Arapaho tribes, permanent settlement near Clear Creek in 1858, and service as Colorado's Territorial Capital; and

WHEREAS, "Golden City" was established in 1859, incorporated in 1871, and renamed "Golden" in 1872; and

WHEREAS, members of the Golden community care deeply about understanding and honoring our history by protecting historic sites and buildings and celebrating historic events; and

WHEREAS, our community is vigilant about preserving our small-town historic character; and

WHEREAS, June 12, 2009 is Golden's 150th birthday; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Ritter proclaimed the City of Golden as the Colorado Capital for one day June, 12, 1009; and

WHEREAS, The 150 Golden Years Committee has done an exceptional job of planning Golden's sesquicentennial celebration; and

WHEREAS, the citizens, businesses and organizations in this community are showing tremendous support for the planned activities and parade and, more importantly, the meaning of this event.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADOP:




