

RESOLUTION NO. 1632

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN AUTHORIZING THE RE-ACTIVATION OF A RAIL ROAD CROSSING OF FORD STREET AT VACATED 8TH STREET

WHEREAS, CoorsTek as owner of the manufacturing facility at 600 9th Street has requested that the City authorize the re-activation of a previously utilized rail road crossing of Ford Street at vacated 8th Street for limited use for delivery of materials necessary for the operation of the manufacturing facility; and


WHEREAS, the rail road crossing was in operation for several decades until its' use was discontinued in the early 1990's.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Golden City Council hereby supports the re-activation of the rail road crossing located at Ford Street at vacated 8th Street, and authorizes the City Manager and City Engineer to process and issue necessary permits for installation and operation of said rail road crossing.

Section 2. City Council authorizes City staff to work with CoorsTek to submit any necessary permit applications Public Utilities Commission.




