

RESOLUTION NO. 1818

**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL
APPROVING THE REQUEST FOR CITY FUNDS TO BE
APPLIED TO CLEAR CREEK TRAIL SOUTH SIDE
EXTENSION AND CLEAR CREEK PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE**

WHEREAS, the City of Golden Parks and Recreation Department is desiring to further develop a safe, comprehensive and multipurpose trail system that promotes walking and other forms of non-motorized travel; and

WHEREAS, the Clear Creek corridor is a valuable community and region resource for transportation and recreational activities including use of the current and future trail system; and

WHEREAS, the addition of a South side trail from 6th Ave on the West to the Billy Drew bridge on the East, and the addition of a pedestrian bridge East of 6th Ave would provide residents from Golden and Jefferson County with improved and additional trail access and connections in the popular Clear Creek corridor.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Golden City Council approves Golden's Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and staff's request for City funds to be applied to Clear Creek trail South side extension and Clear Creek pedestrian bridge.


Section 2. The Golden City Council hereby authorizes the Golden Parks and Recreation Department to apply for Jefferson County Open Space Joint Venture Grants in the amount of \$259,026 which is equal to 50% of the total of both projects. The City of Golden will contribute \$259,026 for these projects, for total projects development costs of \$518,052.
