RESOLUTION NO. 2029

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING THE CONVEYANCE OF TWO PARCELS OF LAND FOR A POTENTIAL ROADWAY, AND ACKNOWLEDGING THE SATISFACTION OF CONDITIONS IMPOSED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1697

- WHEREAS, on April 14, 2005 the Golden City Council approved Ordinance No. 1697, which ordinance conditionally approved a vacation of a portion of Maple Street, a portion of 16th Street, and the alley located within Block 77 of the plat of the south side of Clear Creek; and
- WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1697 authorized the closure of said street segments, but required the satisfaction of certain conditions before the right of way vacations would go into effect; and
- WHEREAS, on July 24, 2008 City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1817 reenacting in part Ordinance No. 1697 and amending Section 3 of the ordinance to extend the period for compliance until December 31, 2009; and
- WHEREAS, the Colorado School of Mines submitted a roadway "easement" prior to December 31, 2009 to satisfy the remaining condition, and subsequently, at the request of the City, submitted the deeds attached hereto as Exhibits A-1 and A-2; and
- WHEREAS, the Colorado School of Mines initially complied with the requirements for closure of the streets, and has now submitted conveyance documents, which if executed and delivered, are necessary to satisfy the conditions for the subject right of way vacations to go into effect; and
 - WHEREAS, City Council has considered the land conveyance to the City of Golden.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:
- Section 1. City Council accepts the conveyance of fee title to the property, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibits A-1 and A-2 ("conveyance documents"), subject to the final execution and delivery of the conveyance documents by the Colorado School of Mines. The Mayor is authorized to acknowledge the City's acceptance of the conveyance.
- Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 1697, City Council hereby finds that all of the conditions of Ordinance 1697 will be satisfied upon the execution and delivery of the conveyance documents, and the Mayor will be authorized to execute a recordable "Certificate" to document that the right of way vacations authorized by Ordinance No. 1697 are fully effective.
- Section 3. In the event that fully executed conveyance documents are not delivered to the City before February 25, 2010, this resolution shall be void and of no effect.


