CLEANUP REGULATIONS IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN**


WHEREAS, under Colorado law the City of Golden may designate the County Health Department as the "Governing Body" to administer methamphetamine lab clean-up operations; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:






