

RESOLUTION NO. 1738

**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL  
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN  
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR MUTUAL AID  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF GOLDEN AND THE JEFFERSON  
COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Golden has provided mutual aid to various government agencies located within the Denver Metropolitan area in the past, and

WHEREAS, there is a real threat in the event of the occurrence of an emergency epidemic which results from cases of a communicable or non-communicable illness or condition caused by bioterrorism, pandemic influenza, or a novel or highly fatal infectious agent or biological toxin, and

WHEREAS, sites are being designated to serve as local dispensing sites of vaccines from the Strategic National Stockpile, and

WHEREAS, in the event that an emergency epidemic or a disaster emergency caused by an emergency epidemic has been declared by executive order or proclamation of the governor of the State of Colorado or otherwise officially declared, and

WHEREAS, the City of Golden is the owner/manager of a facility known as The Golden Community Center, located at 1470 10<sup>th</sup> Street in Golden, Colorado which is suitable for use as a vaccine dispensing site in the event of an emergency epidemic, and


WHEREAS, this agreement shall not replace or supersede any other Agreement(s) between the Participating Entities or a portion thereof.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:


Section 1. The City of Golden agrees to allow the Golden Community Center to be available for use as a vaccine dispensing site by the Jefferson County Department of Health and Environment or designated civil defense workers.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to sign the attached mutual aid agreement with the Participating Entities within the State of Colorado, the County of Jefferson and the City of Golden.





# Prophylaxis Clinic Site Mutual Aid Agreement

## AGREEMENT

This Agreement made and entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2006, by and between City of Golden, (hereinafter "Site Volunteer"), and Jefferson County Department of Health and Environment (hereinafter "Department").

## RECITALS

As part of Jefferson County's Disaster Emergency planning and preparation process, sites are being designated to serve as local dispensing sites of vaccines from the Strategic National Stockpile or other supply sources in the event of the occurrence of an emergency epidemic which results from cases of a communicable or non-communicable illness or condition caused by bioterrorism, pandemic influenza, or a novel or highly fatal infectious agent or biological toxin.

Site Volunteer is the owner/manager of a facility know as The Golden Community Center, located at 1470 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Golden, Colorado which is suitable for use as a vaccine dispensing site in the event of an emergency epidemic.

Department and Site Volunteer desire the above referenced site to be listed in a confidential annex to the local plan for emergency epidemics and disaster emergencies caused by emergency epidemics on the terms and conditions outlined in this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

In the event that an emergency epidemic or a disaster emergency caused by an emergency epidemic has been declared by executive order or proclamation of the governor of the State of Colorado or otherwise officially declared, Site Volunteer agrees to make its site available for use as a vaccine dispensing site by the Department or designated civil defense workers.

Site Volunteer additionally agrees to allow its facility to be inspected by employees of the State and local departments of health and environment, local law enforcement agencies and members of the National Guard to permit the development and maintenance of a site dispensing plan. These inspections would occur with reasonable advance notice to and the scheduling of a convenient inspection time with the Site Volunteer.

In order to facilitate the use of the site for the purposes of this Agreement, Site Volunteer shall designate the following three individuals by contact in case of an emergency epidemic or disaster emergency caused by an emergency epidemic:

- Rod Tarullo, Director of Parks, Recreation & Golf
- MaryAnne Krebs, Assistant Recreation Director

- Keith Isenberger, Facility Manager

The Department designates Nick Nichols as the individual who is to serve as a point of contact to respond to any questions the Site Volunteer may have about the designation or use of the site for the purpose of this Agreement.

All contacts can be made through the Emergency Dispatch Office of the City of Golden at (303) 384-8045, 24 hours a day/7 days a week.

C.R.S. § 24-32-2302(2) provides an exemption from civil liability for owners of property who make their property available for civil defense purposes without compensation.

To the extent that the United States government does not assume liability for damage to property, injury or death to persons caused by the use of the site for the purposes of this Agreement, the State of Colorado has agreed under the provisions of C.R.S. § 24-32-2303 to assume legal liability for such damages.

This agreement shall be in effect for the period of January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007.

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
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


